The 65th Annual Strawberry Festival was an abundance of blessings yet again! Perfect weather, a wonderful variety of cakes

and plenty of volunteers, thank the Lord! We love that we were able to keep this as a free will offering event and members and visitors gave generously. We estimate well over 3,000 attendees graced our grounds. We are thankful for a \$1,500 donation requested and received from Holman Community Outreach, a generous \$300 donation from Lewis Funeral Home, donated iced tea from Chick Fil-A Mount Laurel, ice cream donations from Wegmans, and multiple donations from congregants.

Thank you to everyone who visited the Missions Food Tent, whose proceeds will support Haiti Outreach Ministries and a donation towards UP Honduras when our mission team visits in July. The goal of this event always has been community outreach to bring people together and show them the love of God. Historically, the goal has never been a "for profit" event, but rather the hope has always been to adequately cover the expenses of the Festival with any proceeds going towards additional FPC Moorestown community outreach. Early numbers indicate 2024 was a huge success!

Over the years, the Strawberry Festival has evolved, mostly since the pandemic, with a strategic intent to decrease the number of volunteers needed while being more efficient and cost effective. Changing to individual portions of ice cream cut our costs by \$1,500, in addition to decreasing strain on volunteers and producing significantly less waste. Unused ice cream is kept in the freezer and utilized for VBS, after Family Dinners or youth events and the kids absolutely love that! Keeping the event outdoors decreases cleaning time and costs for the inside areas as well.

June 16-29, 2024 (2-wk)

From young to old this event is a highlight of the year for many in the community. As you looked around that night, it was endearing to see so many kids and adults dressed in strawberry themed outfits. There was a couple from California who was back visiting family, and the wife stated she had grown up in Moorestown and came to this event as a child over 40 years ago. She was so excited to share this event with her husband and revel in the nostalgia of it all with her sisters. Not many events these days have staying power like this!

Volunteers are the backbone of our Strawberry Festival. We need your commitment now to make next year a success. Limited commitment by members in the future may require additional changes, such as decreasing the Festival to 2 hours to ensure we can cover all volunteer roles. While we appreciate people asking how they can help the night of, we can better prepare if we know you are committed to coming before the event, allowing us to balance specific needs. We strive to start the evening with each shift fully covered. This year, that meant many people had to cover multiple shifts. We pray that ALL have the ability to enjoy the night and want to ensure that some do not have to work the entire event.

This beloved annual event can only happen with the support of the entire congregation in all ways, big and small! Please help us continue to Grow the Kingdom and mark the date of the 2025 Strawberry Festival on your calendar now!
