Teach us to lay up treasure in heaven, Lord, for truly, where our treasure is, our hearts will also be engaged. Prompt us by the Holy Spirit that we might set our minds on things unseen and put into action this eternal focus. May we become a community of faith that sows generously into Your work, that we might also reap generously.

May we give to You with great joy, a good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and *running over*---that the same might be poured back onto us---and Your kingdom work increase all the more! May we be generous in all things and, in doing so, experience Your great blessing.
