Do you know that SOLA SCRIPTURA is symbolized in our worship on Sunday morning? The term Sola Scriptura is a Latin phrase meaning "by Scripture alone." The doctrine was a rallying cry during the 16th century Protestant Reformation. It proclaimed the sufficiency of Scripture as our supreme authority and the Bible as the sole source of our Christian faith and practice. When the Beadle carries the Bible into our church at the opening of our service, we are proclaiming that the inspired word of God is present and we acknowledge that the Bible is our foremost authority in worship.
