Because of budgetary restraints there were no capital funds budgeted for 2025. Instead, leadership offers the congregation the chance to give specifically to these projects during a Capital Campaign. Per Capita Support (I Will Give) -- As Presbyterians, we are a connectional church. The annual "per member" or "per capita" contribution of \$38.75 above one's pledge supports the General Assembly, Synod and Presbytery. Our church is required to pay this assessment. Your Stewardship Team asks you to cover your share of \$38.75/each per member. If you do NOT wish the church to pay your Per Capita, you must submit an opt-out form online (see event page). The church must pay for all non-responding members. Please note not responding is NOT the same as opting out. Per Capita payments and opt-out requests are due by February 28. (This contribution is not deducted from one's pledge.)
